

Ignite Festival Camping Rules and Info.

1. All campsites, including Friday early arrival, will be assigned on a **first come, first serve basis**. NO saving space will be allowed. Please arrive as a group if you want to be placed together.
2. You will not be issued a campsite unless you have someone 18 years or older camping with you on the site. A photo identification will be required upon campsite assignment for the adult who will be camping for the duration of the festival. Parents cannot sign for a campsite unless they are staying at the site.
3. **Seating at the concert arena** will not open until after 3:30PM. NO reserving seats at the arena. All blankets/tarps must be occupied. If left unoccupied, they will be removed and placed to the side.
4. **No lawn chairs** are allowed in the area directly in front of the sound tower. All chairs and blankets must be removed each night after the last concert. Any blankets/chairs left behind will be removed.
5. All campers need to **limit their driving** to a minimum around the Ignite Festival area for safety reasons. You are allowed **one** vehicle per campsite. You can unload additional vehicles, but you will then be asked to move additional vehicles off the camping areas to the free offsite parking space provided. Please cooperate in keeping the site safe.
6. **First Aid** is available at the medical tent from the hours of 11:00 A.M. to 12:00 A.M. Water is available for emergency purposes only. There is no water supply on site – so please make sure you bring plenty with you.
7. There are **no showers** provided at the Ignite Festival.
8. **Drinking water** is not provided. Individual bottles of water will be sold at various vendors throughout the festival.
9. No pets are allowed on the grounds (unless a guide dog used for the visually impaired).
10. **Camp Fires**. All campsite fires must be kept small and contained in a grill, fire ring or ground container. The site should be left in the same condition as when you arrived. No cutting limbs or damaging trees to obtain fire wood. You are welcome to gather firewood from the ground only.
11. **Trash**. Keep your campsite clean! All trash must be placed in the trash cans and dumpsters provided around the festival area. Use plastic bags and do not leave trash outside where animals can get at it. Please clean your camping area before exiting the area.
12. **Small generators** can be used, but must be turned **off at 1:00 am** each evening. Keep fuel away from all fires.
13. **Only small campers**, trailers, RV under 27 feet, and pop-up campers can be placed on the primitive campsites. All vehicles must be shut off while parked in the camping area to avoid exhaust fumes injuring adjacent campers. NO EXCEPTIONS.
14. Only vehicles with a numbered Ignite **parking permit** can park on the campsite. All vehicles parked in the camping area should remain parked and not be driven through the festival area during the festival unless needed for an emergency. Always drive slow in the park with extreme caution and below 5 MPH.
15. There is a **1:00 AM quiet time** for all campers. No loud radios, cd players, music or boom boxes are allowed after this time. No wandering through the camping areas after the 1:00 AM curfew. Individuals who disturb other campers or use abusive, indecent language will be asked to leave the festival. Security and Ignite Safety Staff are on-site 24 hours.

16. No golf carts, dirt bikes, or other motorized vehicles (other than Ignite staff vehicles) are allowed at the festival.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES & DRUGS

These are absolutely not permitted on the festival grounds and those found under the influence of, or in possession of such will be escorted off the property, and or, turned over to the law enforcement officials

CAMERAS

Regular cameras and video cameras are permitted at Ignite. However, any professional camera equipment (including tripods, cameras with removable lenses, etc) is not. Photos must be taken from where ever you will be standing/sitting during the performances... no special passes will be issued. Also, video-taping of an entire performance is prohibited. This is agreed upon by the Ignite Festival and the performing artist to protect the artists' rights. Thank you for your cooperation.

DRESS CODE

Leaders, Chaperones and Parents: We need your help in enforcing this policy - our staff cannot do it alone! MODESTY is the key word. While the style and fashion these days seems to be "less is best," we do not want to be guilty of causing another person to stumble. Girls: Bathing suits are NOT permitted. Tank tops are fine but bellies must be covered (even though the fashion now is to show it off). Shorts and/or skirts need to be long enough and shirts big enough. Guys are not exempt from the dress code: SHIRTS (and shoes) MUST be worn by all at all times.

FIREWORKS

No personal fireworks may be brought onto the grounds

FRISBEES, ETC.

Please confine athletic activities to areas not congested by people

LITERATURE DISTRIBUTION

Literature distribution is only permitted from official booths located in the booth area, regardless of the type of literature. Please understand that this rule will be strictly enforced.

SMOKING

Smoking is not allowed in the public areas of the festival. If you need to smoke, please limit this to your own campsite or off festival grounds.

WHAT TO BRING

Pen and notebook, sleeping bag, tent or camper, flashlight, cooking supplies, buckets, BIBLE, wash basin, umbrella, toothpaste, soap, towels, insect repellent, money, sunglasses, hat, sweater, and blanket.
